These awards are for children who have shown they are wonderful role models and have an amazing attitude to learning - trying their best all the time.

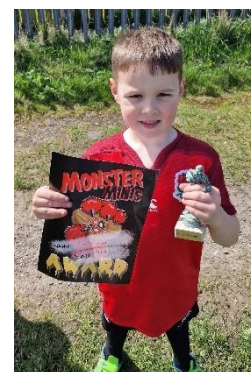

Congratulations to our two rugby teams who played this week.

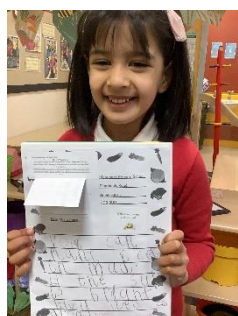
