<u>Phonics</u>

This week, please practise all the different ways we can make an 'A' sound (ay, a_e, ai, a (as in <u>a</u>corn). As usual please practice the **phase 5 tricky words** (please see the Year 1 homework page on the website for a list of tricky words).


