



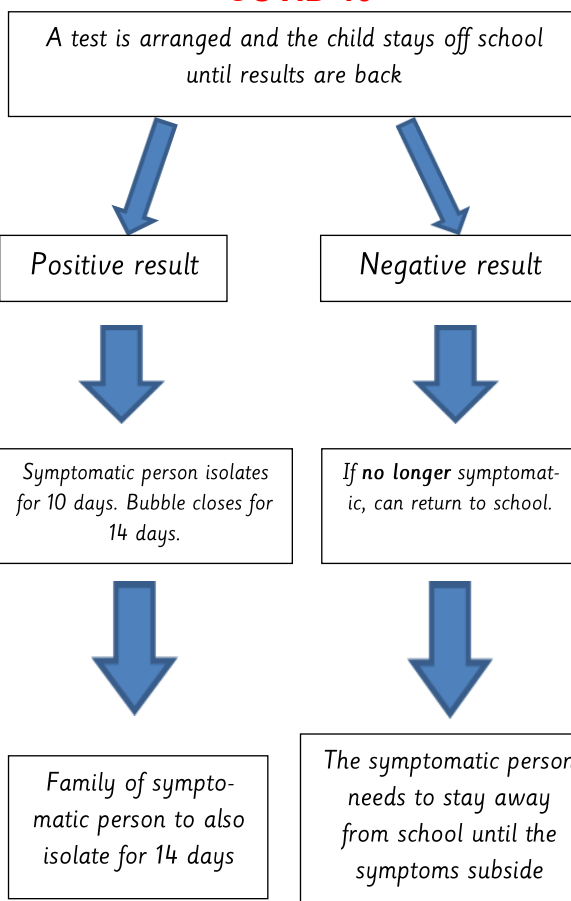
We have written this Home-School contract between Moorlands Primary, Parents/Carers and Children to ensure the safety of everybody.

We assume that if you are sending your child to school, you agree to this Home-School Agreement.



## Parent/Carer

### What to do if my child, or someone in our household develops symptoms of COVID-19



Parents also need to be aware that if a member of staff in your child's bubble is symptomatic, we may need to temporarily close that group to preserve the integrity of the bubble.



## Children



### GREEN ZONE



Keep yourself and others safe. Stay in your bubble.
Be polite and kind
Be respectful and considerate of other people & property
Keep your hands and feet to yourself
Listen to others and follow instructions
Be positive and cheerful
Always try your best

#### Rewards

No pegs all week = green frog sticker to take home & Merit
Green all term = a treat from the Good to Be Green box.
Merits=Bronze, Silver, Gold and Platinum Awards plus contributing your merits to your House Team.

Deliberately leaving your bubble.
Time wasting
Not listening to others
Shouting out

#### Consequences

4 <sup>th</sup> warning = yellow card given & miss whole playtime. Name is added to behaviour file.
3 <sup>rd</sup> warning= second peg given & 5 minutes off playtime
2 <sup>nd</sup> warning = peg given & frog lost for that week
1 <sup>st</sup> warning = Spoken to about behaviour

Deliberately coughing or spitting at others!
Swearing!
Disrespecting adults!
Violence!
Racist / Verbal Abuse

#### Consequences

Miss the next 5 consecutive playtimes or 2 lunchtimes
Name added to behaviour file and parents informed.
Children putting themselves or others at risk will be removed from the classroom and can only return when safe to do so.



## School

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection;
- Promote the government's social distancing guidance in an age appropriate way and make our best endeavour to keep the children socially distanced;
- Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's social, emotional and academic needs;
- Contact parents/carers if a child displays symptoms of COVID-19;
- Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' show symptoms of COVID-19 and instruct you to follow the COVID-19 flowchart (overleaf)
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy and addendum as well the expectations outlined in this agreement;
- Communicate between home and school through text, email and the school website;
- Signpost to online learning for those self-isolating and move to blended learning for any closed bubbles;
- Continue to be approachable and be a 'virtual' listening ear should parents need it;
- Continually review and reassess plans as and when developments, including new government guidance appears;
- Share information with families about new guidance, routines and plans as quickly as we can. Work with the local cluster and the Local Authority for the best needs of our school.



## Parent/Carer

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will follow the COVID-19 flowchart.
- If I am informed that my child shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately;
- On my commute to and from school, and when dropping off/picking, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules and bring no additional people with me (unless absolutely necessary) avoiding socialising with other adults on the school grounds and leaving as soon as I've dropped my child off.
- I will only use public transport if absolutely necessary & ensure I socially distance & wear a face covering, if I do;
- When dropping off & picking up, I will be punctual, adhering to the adjusted school timings for my child.
- My child must not bring any unnecessary items into or take items home from school and all prescribed medication will be sent into school
- I will remind my child about social distancing rules, understanding that they are difficult to maintain for primary aged pupils.
- My child will need to use good respiratory and hand hygiene
- My child will be dressed in uniform each day.
- Children will not be allowed to play in the playground before or after school.
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this period, by communicating via email or telephone.
- I need to read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home;
- I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carers and emergency contacts details.
- I understand that If my child is unsafe in school, he/she will be sent home and may be asked to complete home learning instead of being in school



## Children

- I must stay in my bubble throughout the day.
- I will stay in my allocated area at break-time and lunchtime and ask if I am unsure.
- I must move around the school in my bubble, following the one-way system on staircases and walk on the left in most areas of school.
- I will enter and exit the dining room at the correct places and ask if I am unsure.
- I will avoid touching my mouth, nose and eyes with my hands.
- If I sneeze or cough I will use tissues and put it in the bin. ('catch it, bin it, kill it').
- I will tell an adult if I am feeling unwell.
- I will take care of my own pencils and pens and will not share them or put them in my mouth.
- I will only use the toilets closest to classroom.
- I MUST NOT cough or spit at or towards any other person
- I understand there will be consequences if I do not follow these rules.
