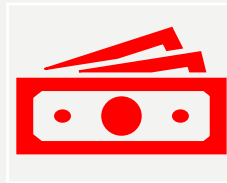
# PARENTPAY

What is  
ParentPay?



- Payment system – we don't have the facilities to take cash payments – all payments should be made via ParentPay (eg milk, school trips, etc)



- Communication system – all texts and most e-mails will be sent out to you using ParentPay and you will be asked to communicate with us via ParentPay too.

# PAYMENT SYSTEM

- Very similar to on-line shopping. Items to be paid for are displayed as a 'Payment Item'. Just select the item you want to pay for, provide any information that is requested, add the item to your basket and then make your payment.
- Each payment item will be accompanied by a short description so that it is clear what you are paying for.



# COMMUNICATION SYSTEM

- All texts and most e-mails will be sent out to you via ParentPay (e.g. school closures for bad weather, weekly newsletters, information on up and coming events such as school trips, etc).
- You will also be asked to respond via ParentPay where a response to school is required (e.g. confirmation of attendance at Parents Information Evenings, permission for your child to take part in events in or outside school, etc).



# HOW TO ACCESS PARENTPAY

- A username and password generated by ParentPay will be sent home with your child during the first week they are at Moorlands.
- You should change the username to your e-mail address and add a mobile phone number.
- ParentPay will use these for our e-mail and text communications with you, so please keep this information up-to-date both on ParentPay and with the School Office.
- We recommend that you activate your ParentPay account as soon as you receive your login details. Our first event which will require a response from you will be held on September 28<sup>th</sup>, this will be a 'how we learn in reception' evening.
- If you have any queries or problems, please contact the School Office— we are always happy to help at any time.

# FREE SCHOOL MEALS & PUPIL PREMIUM

Parents or carers receive one or more of the following:

- Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods)
- Income support
- Income Based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit, but are not entitled to a Working Tax Credit and your annual income (as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs) is less than £16,190
- Support under Part V1 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Guaranteed element of State Pension Credit

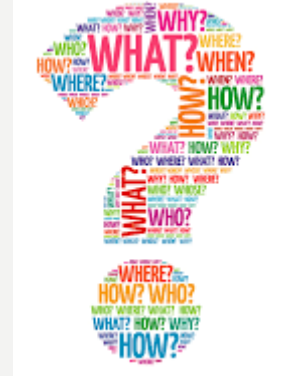
