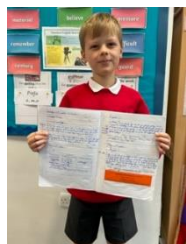
The bar will be open, cash prize for the winning team and we will have a raffle with some fabulous prizes!

We are delighted to share that the following students are this week's recipients of these awards.

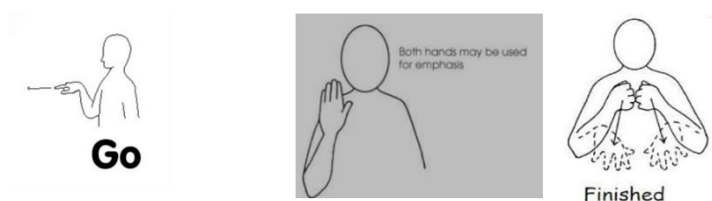

Would you like to become a Reading Friends volunteer at Moorlands Primary School? Would you like to help develop a child's ability to read as well as promote a love of reading for children at our school?

At Moorlands Primary school, we are looking for volunteers to come in and read with children in our school.

What is Reading Friends?

Reading Friends is a project which involves adults dedicating a small amount of their time to read with the children in school. The aim is to enable children to absorb and enjoy books by basing the support strategies of their Reading Friends on the principles of 'Reading for Understanding'. We recognise the importance of phonetic awareness as well as recognising that some children may benefit from the additional reading support based largely on helping a child to understand and enjoy stories. The overall aim is to create an environment where children can enjoy books through understanding them better thanks to the support of enthusiastic, committed adult Reading Friends.

On average children improve their reading age up to 9 months after a 10-week programme of reading becoming more confident and showing enjoyment for reading.
