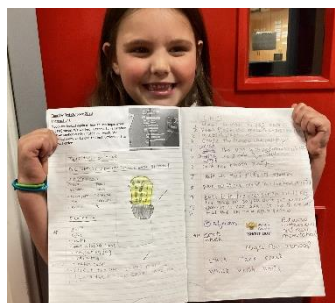
Christmas Cards

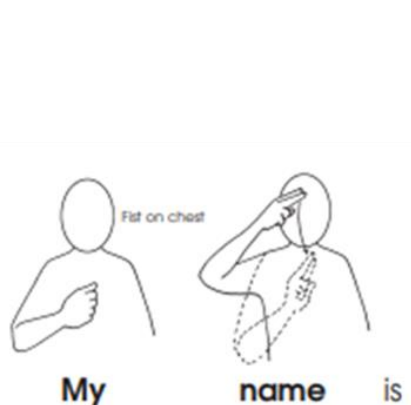


Sign of the week
