Shout Outs




finished just outside the winning positions. They all received a participation medal in recognition of how well they played. Well done! Luca in 2J recently competed in some rugby matches in Bradford. He

Safe School Drop Off

We are becoming increasingly concerned about the number of parents/carers who are pulling up close to the school entrance to drop their children at school.
