Reception Visit to Church



Due to fire regulations, we have limited tickets to 250 per performance. If you have not got a ticket, please do not come to the performance as we will not be able to let you in and it is not fair to ask staff at the doors.

Please drop children off for the evening performances in **FULL SCHOOL UNIFORM** at the following locations and pick them up afterwards from the same place. Please ensure you bring your tickets.

Tuesday, 19th - Years 1 and 2: Drop children at their classroom doors at 5.00pm so that we can get everybody ready. Once you have dropped your child off you need to make your way round to the hall with your ticket.

Thursday, 21st - Years 3 and 4: Drop children at their usual entrance doors at 4.30pm so that we can get everybody ready. Once you have dropped your child off you need to make your way to the hall with your ticket.

Thursday, 21st - Years 5 and 6: Drop children at their normal entrance doors at 6.10pm. Once you have dropped your child off you can take a seat in the hall if you have a ticket.

After the performance, parents are asked to line up outside the collection door (please note this will be their usual exit door) and the children will be dismissed one at a time. Children will not be allowed to leave without an adult collecting them.

Please note that the footpath gate on Moorlands Road and the gate at the back of school will be locked for the evening performances. The School Council will be on the doors collecting money to go towards School Council projects. Please donate if you can.

Please do not use the staff car park for any of the performances. It will be particularly busy around 6pm on Thursday as one performance ends and the children for the next performance arrive. Where possible please walk to avoid congestion.

Dear Parents,

I am delighted to inform you that following the success of previous year's courses we are expanding the football coaching programme for the season. The course will run on a weekly basis **EVERY TUESDAY** during school term times.

All of our courses are run by F.A. QUALIFIED COACHES INCLUDING EX-PROFESSIONAL PLAYERS. All of our coaches have been DBS/CRB POLICE CHECKED. The course is open to boys and girls aged between 4 and 13. All abilities are catered for with total beginners introduced through FUN and confidence building practices. The course is tightly structured to ensure all aspects of football skills are developed.

At the end of the term(usually 10-15 weeks) every child will receive an engraved merit trophy and course certificate, with chances to win extra trophies including penalty shoot out, american shoot out and champions league competitions.

The cost of the course is £7 per week, which is payable every four weeks (£28) with the first payment due on week one. Parents are welcome to stay and watch however the club is fully supervised so children may be left in our care. We have the use of excellent facilities with the course held indoors in the large sports hall.
