three medals for her super dancing. Well done 😊

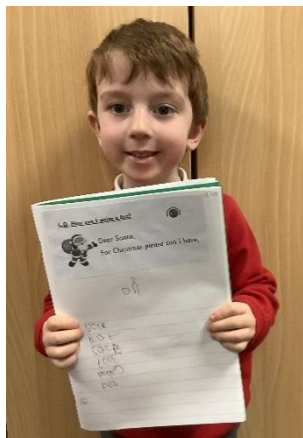






PTA
