After this date, it will not be possible for you to buy tickets or to exchange them with someone else. This is to ensure correct medical/dietary information can be collated in advance of the Disco and to enable the PTA to purchase appropriate amounts of refreshments.

Please note, all children need to be picked up from the disco, they will not be able to walk home on their own. Please ensure any medication your child may need is sent to the disco (e.g. inhalers etc). Mobile phones must not be brought. When dropping off your child, please take their coat home with you and bring it at pick up as we don't have space to store them all.

There will be stalls for your child to purchase extra things on the night – including sweets, crisps, drinks, small toys/keyrings, cakes and biscuits. Please note that this time we are not serving hot dogs. Please send change if you can! Water will be available free of charge.

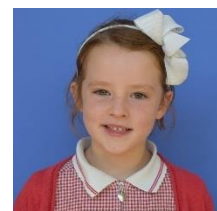

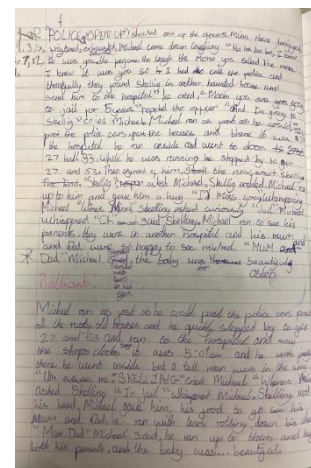
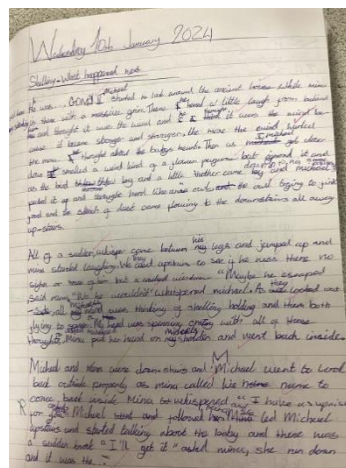
## Reception Playground
