That there is the possibility of a fine of up to £2,500 or 3 month imprisonment for non-payment of a penalty notice should the case go to court. That if I remove my child/ren from school for an unauthorised holiday the school has the right to remove the child/ren from the school register and may give the place/s to another child/other children.
